Rev. Angela M. Redman currently serves as the first female CEO/Executive Director of The United Methodist Church City Society a 185-year-old faith based multi-faceted social service organization. A native of The Bronx, she is a proud graduate of the City of New York University system., having obtained an A.A.S. in Paralegal Studies from Bronx Community College, a B.A. in Black studies from H. Lehman College, and a Juris Doctor at the City University of New York School of Law. She also holds a Master of Divinity degree from New York Theological Seminary.

As an Elder in the New York Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church (NYAC) she has served as pastor of New Rochelle United Methodist Church & First United Methodist Church of Hollis. Rev. Redman has served as the President of the NYAC's Board of Trustees, and various other NYAC committees as well as a study leader for the UMW School of Missions and an instructor for the Metropolitan District's Lay Servant School, as well as conducting a district trustee orientation.

In addition to being an Elder, she has been an attorney for more than twenty years. In her legal career she has worked for the New York State Unified Court's Office for Justice Initiatives and as a court Attorney in New York County Civil Court, Kings County Family Court, New York County Supreme Court, and Bronx County Civil Court; and practiced real estate, estates, and elder law. Additionally, she has been an adjunct professor in the Law and Paralegal Department of the New York City School Technology for over fifteen years.
